Title: Procurement of Bulk Water Meter

1. The Peoples Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Program, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract for "Procurement of Bulk Water Meter" for Dhaka WASA under Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project of DWASA, Contract No. ICB-03.2. This contract will be jointly financed by ADB and the Government of Bangladesh (GoB). The eligibility rules and procedures of the ADB will govern the bidding process.
2. The Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for "Procurement of Bulk Water Meter" for Dhaka WASA under Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project of DWASA. The delivery/completion period is 120 days.
3. International competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: Two-Envelope Bidding Procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project and inspect the Bidding Document at the address given below, from 09:00 to 17:00 hours.
5. The Bidding Document, in the English language, may be purchased by interested Bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee BDT. 5000.00 or in US\$ 75. The method of payment will be Demand Draft or Pay Order in favor of 'Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project'. The document will be sent by hand to the Bidders or their representatives. No liability will be accepted for loss or late delivery.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 12:00 Hours (Bangladesh time), - 29 April 2010. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of BDT 5,00,000 or US\$ 7,300 or an equivalent amount in other freely convertible currency. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at: 12:30 pm (Bangladesh time), 29 April 2010.
7. The Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by Bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of Bids.
8. In the comparison of Bids, ADB's Domestic Preference Scheme will be applied in accordance with the provisions stipulated in the Instructions to Bidders.
