1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project. Part of this loan will be used for payments under the contract named above. This contract will be jointly financed by ADB and the Government of Bangladesh (GoB). Bidding is open to bidders both national and international contractor (Eligible ADB sources country) having requisite experience in water supply pipeline installation and rehabilitation works.
2. The Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (DWASA) represented by the Project Director, Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project (DWSSDP), (Employer) invites sealed Bids from eligible bidders having requisite experience in water supply pipeline installation and rehabilitation work for the "**Development and Operation of District Metered Area (DMA) ID No 617, including rehabilitation, installation and extension of main and service water lines at Khilgaon Taltala and East-Rampura under DWSSDP, Dhaka WASA**".(NCB - Tender-42/PW/DWSSDP/10) The completion period is 24 months (9 month for establishment of DMA and construction expansion & rehabilitation and 15 months for Operation and Maintenances of DMA). National competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's "Single-Stage" small works Bidding Procedure (**Single-Stage, Two-Envelope**).
3. Only eligible bidders with the following key qualification should participate in the bidding
 - i) Experience under construction contracts in the role of contractor for at least the last 10 years prior to the applications submission deadline. (**Must be documented**)
 - ii) Participation as contractor, management contractor in at least one similar contracts within the last 10 years, each with a value of at least **BDT 38 million (0.55 million US\$)** that have been successfully or are substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed works. (**Must be documented**)
 - iii) Minimum average annual construction turnover of **BDT 126.00 million (1.85 million US\$)**, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last 3 years. (**Must be documented**)
 - iv) The minimum amount of free funds (liquid assets) and/or credit facilities net of other Contractual commitments shall be: **BDT 35 million (0.50 million US\$)** (**Must be documented**).

The method of payment will be Demand Draft or Pay Order in favor of 'Project Director, Dhaka Water Supply Sector Development Project'. The Bidding Document can either be (a) picked up by the Bidder or its representative from the Employer's office, or (b) sent by the Employer to the Bidder by mail, and for this purpose the Bidder is to pay an additional fee of Tk. 5,000 or US\$ 75. No liability will be accepted for loss or late delivery.
6. The Employer will arrange for a pre-bid meeting to be held at 11.00 AM on 28 June 2010. Bidders are encouraged strongly to attend the pre-bid meeting with their specialist technical persons for the works.
